



## **Statement condemning the Israeli aggression against Lebanon**

On March 2, 2026, the Israeli Air Force carried out a massive aggression against several areas of Lebanese territory, causing the death and injury of dozens of civilians, including children, in addition to widespread destruction of infrastructure and public and private property.

While the aggression is still ongoing as of the writing of this statement, the past few days have witnessed the displacement of thousands of families from their neighborhoods and homes that were bombed, especially in southern Lebanon, the southern suburb of Beirut, and the Bekaa Valley. Many of these families are in difficult humanitarian conditions seeking to secure shelter to protect them from cold and rain, in addition to the need to secure water, food, medicine, etc.

The raids also targeted Palestinian refugees, as aircraft hit the Beddawi refugee camp in northern Lebanon at dawn on March 5, killing a refugee family and wounding others.

Meanwhile, the Israeli military's Arabic-language spokesperson issued new forced displacement orders for residents of the Beirut southern suburb, including the Burj al-Barajneh Palestinian refugee camp, to evacuate immediately, which means the displacement of tens of thousands of residents from their homes amid these tragic circumstances.

This blatant aggression comes at a time when Lebanon and the countries of the region are suffering from severe economic and humanitarian crises as a result of years of wars and conflicts fueled by regional and foreign countries to preserve their interests.

We at the Jafra Foundation for Relief and Youth Development strongly condemn the aggression against Lebanon and the region and call on the international community to assume its responsibility in imposing international law on Tel-Aviv to stop its crimes against safe civilians.
