Jafra for Relief and Youth Development



Since the very onset of COVID19 pandemic in Syria, urgent need for all precautionary medical and logistic necessities has emerged, due to the hard circumstances of the war-ravaged country.

One of the most urgent need at the time was the medical mask, which forced us work to produce masks by ourselves in order to meet the shortfall. Till December 2020 we could produce over 7,000 masks.

Jafra center in Qudsaya with efforts of 9 ladies who had volunteered to participate in this initiative under the supervision of a specialist trainer, distributed the masks on the households in Qudsaya and the camps in conjunction with disinfection campaigns and bread distribution drives.



Jafra in Jaramana camp held a training for the volunteers on the creation of initiatives. The training included the definition of the initiative, the initiative life cycle, characteristics of the people with initiatives and mechanisms of implementation.



Ladies have a special place in our programs, so, we are always keen to offer them all support and empowerment as this will be positively reflected on the society. Jafra center in South Damascus is holding an English course for 15 housewives to acquire skills in English that enable them to support their children in their attainment.



Jafra center in Homs camp was notably active during the last month of 2020. In addition to the education program for all levels, the Center held a number of sessions for children to create a common space for discussion and reflection on different topics like conflict, child rights, etc. English classes and ICDL courses were also held regularly.
