Jafra for Relief and Youth Development



Within its plan to prevention of Coronavirus, Jafra Foundation has launched and participated in a number of disinfection drives in the Foundation's whereabouts in Syria.

The drives targeted different areas in cooperation with official and civil organizations. As in Al-Wafideen camp in Rural Damascus, Jafra team in cooperation with Al-Batiha municipality council launched a disinfection campaign including schools, dispensaries, mosques and public utilities. In Jaramana camp, Jafra took part in disinfecting of Bustan Talal school Al-Rahman kindergarten, Jaramana camp and the martyr Ahmad Abu Omar dispensary.

In Qudsaya, our volunteers participated in a campaign to clean and disinfect the streets of the town in cooperation with Qudsaya municipality council and Qudsaya Youth League.



Within the youth support and empowerment program, Jafra center in Qudsaya held a new course in computer science principles, Internet and mobile.

The course was run in cooperation with the social care center of the Syrian Red Crescent and funded by the UNHCR.

Furthermore, Jafra held an active learning course to empower the teaching cadre in dealing with the students using the most up-to-date educational process methods that consider the students' types and potentials.



January 2021 has witnessed an intense activity in all Jafra centers in Syria regarding the educational program.

Dozens of students have been ready to work with teachers and facilitators in preparation for the 1st semester tests.

Ad hoc Sessions were held to conduct preliminary tests in way similar to those of the official schools, in addition to explanation to children and answering their questions.



63 youth participants have been granted certificates in computer sciences and English language after finishing 3-levels in each of the subject courses in periods of 2 months for each level in Jafra center in Burj El-Barajneh Camp. The center continues to offer these courses to youth in cooperation with AFD and Asmae organizations.



In coordination with “Umm” association, Jafra held a course entitled “Myths in the World of Nutrition, Between Fact and Fiction”.

The course which was presented by the nutritionist Dr. Islam Al-Maqdah, in presence of 25 ladies, has addressed key subjects concerning health preservation.
