Jafra for Relief and Youth Development



On the International Day of Solidarity with the Palestinian People which marks November the 29th, Jafra Foundation held a mass event attended by the Foundation's cadre in Syria. The event included activities that focused on the Palestinian people right to return and the Palestinian national identity. Over 130 Jafra youth from different locations around the country participated in the event.



November the 25th marks the International Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women.

This year was different, as since the COVID19 outbreak, reports have showed an increasing rate of all of violence forms against women and girls; the domestic violence in particular.

In November, Jafra has organized an 8-day training on NGO management in Beirut. The workshop which brought together 17 youth participants from different nationalities was a unique opportunity to acquire the necessary skills to join the humanitarian key actors and support the community in emergency response. The training was carried out in cooperation with centers specialized in capacity building. The participants were introduced to the NGOs basic humanitarian work and the principles and standards governing the work.

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Children attend activities in different times. So, it is not possible that they meet altogether at the same time. Jafra center in Qudsaya decided to gather all of the children together at the same time in order to let them know each other and make new friendships. Over 150 children have participated together in various recreational activities.



Jafra center in Homs Camp continues to offer all support and empowerment to youth through a number of trainings.

During November, two trainings were held. The first training was about the methods of teaching, in which, participant have learnt necessary teaching skills and techniques in order to create an interactive educational environment and grow the students' audio-visual memory. The training was attended by 14 participants. Furthermore, the training offered the trainees the opportunity to access to the job market in the field of education.

The second training was in the field of secretary as the participants were introduced to the secretary skills and tasks; meetings, management and archiving.
