



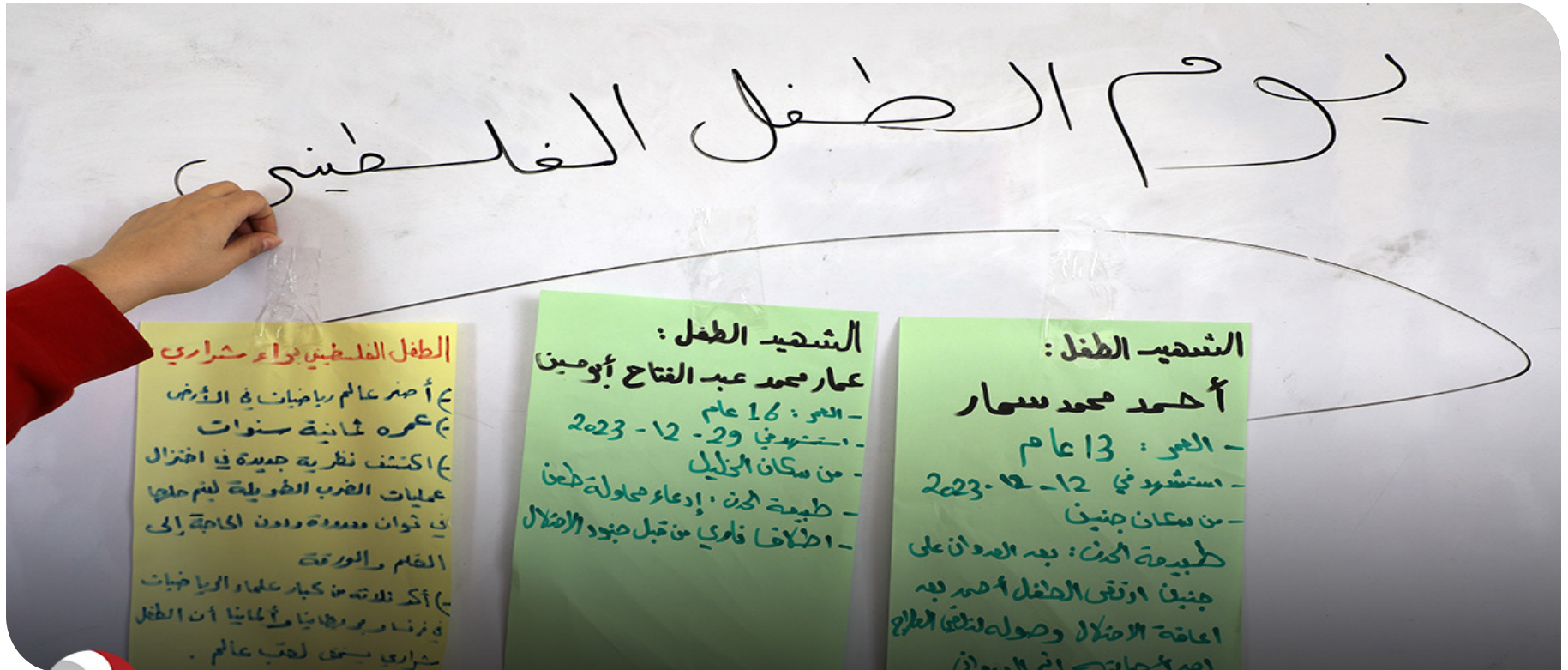

Jafra centers in Syria continue to receive students for the preparatory and secondary school certificates, in addition to the educational program for the primary and middle levels. Jafra Foundation centers commemorated Palestinian Children's Day through a group of different activities to highlight the importance of this occasion and introduce the children of Palestine, including those who have killed, wounded, and the arrested, the suffering of the Palestinian children under occupation. More than 14,000 Palestinian children were killed by the occupation in its genocide against the Gaza Strip, and 31 children died of hunger because the occupation prevented aid convoys from entering the Strip.



By the Eid al-Fitr, over a million children in Gaza were deprived of the joy of Eid due to the bloody war waged by the occupation on the Strip. The children of Gaza live in extremely harsh conditions under bombardment, displacement, hunger, fear and disease. Children in Jafra have expressed their solidarity with the children of Gaza through various activities held by the organization's centers spread across Syria and Lebanon.



Jafra's winter and summer clubs are among our most important programs targeting children. They combine education, fun, enjoyment, and entertainment, and children fill their time with activities that benefit them and raise their abilities, skills, and awareness.
